

OPPOSE THE BOMBING OF IRAN: UPHOLD INTERNATIONAL LAW

TO: THE HOUSE OF COMMONS

WHEREAS:

- Only the people of Iran can liberate themselves and should be able to do so without any foreign interference;
- The February 28 bombing of Iran is clearly against international law;
- The pretext for bombing Iran - preventing the government from acquiring nuclear weapons - is dangerously similar to the claims made against Iraq to justify the 2003 war;
- The 2003 US war on Iraq resulted in over one million direct and indirect casualties of military personnel and civilians and estimates that some 3 million people who were children in 2003 suffer from PTSD;
- The claims that Iraq had “weapons of mass destruction” were proven to be false;
- Canada should be exercising an independent foreign policy, as it did when it did not formally participate alongside the US in Vietnam (and when it welcomed US war resisters); when it refused to participate in the US blockade of Cuba; and when it did not officially participate in the bombing of Iraq in 2003; and
- Today, Canada is complicit in normalizing US President Trump’s aggression and illegal military strikes against sovereign states, including Venezuela, Nigeria, Somalia, Yemen, Syria, Iraq, and Iran; therefore,

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED RESIDENTS OF CANADA call on the Prime Minister Mark Carney and all Members of Parliament to:

- Publicly condemn the bombing of Iran and US violations of international law;
- Call for an immediate ceasefire and de-escalation in the region; and
- Demand protection for civilians and full compliance with international humanitarian law.
